BIDS holds lecture on constitution

A public lecture on constitution of the country was held in the city on Wednesday, organised by Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies (BIDS).

Comptroller and Auditor General of Bangladesh Mohammad Muslim Chowdhury delivered an overview of the constitution styled "Schematic View of Bangladesh Constitution".

In his two-hour long lecture, Mr Chowdhury gave schemes and functionality of the constitution.

He said the constitution of Bangladesh is being divided in 12 parts and all the parts are well connected and well-studied before putting in place.

However, to a query, he refused to answer why constitution of the country doesn't work accordingly for the people and differences remain in practice and theory.

BIDS Director General Binayak Sen delivered opening speech and moderated the session.
